TBES Verge shredders

KUHN and landscape maintenance

The KUHN range of equipment designed for landscape maintenance is growing with the arrival of a new range of verge shredders. Designed for intensive use on ultra-wide tractors, the TBES range completes the existing TB and TBE ranges. Available in 2.30 m and 2.50 m widths, the TBES is particularly recommended for work such as maintaining verges, field edges, ditches and shredding grassy areas.

Assets which make a difference

Based on our experience, the design of the TBES has some original features:

- **Reinforced structure:** The offset arms and pivot points are dimensioned to withstand severe stresses. For optimal reliability, the joints are mounted on bronze bushes and equipped with grease nipples.
- **Optimised shredding box:** High shredding capacity through a specific box shape, forward position of the roller for optimal ground following, passing shredded waste over the roller to eliminate compaction and increase decomposition speed.
- **Kinetics:** Shredding box orientation over a wide range of rotation, from -65° in "ditch" position to +90° in "hedge" position. Large lateral offset for use with wide tractors and work in combination with a front mounted shredder.

Complete standard equipment

The TBES shredder has an unrivalled level of equipment:

- Roller with removable ends and reinforced bearing protection;
- Bolted sheet metal lining;
- Rounded, adjustable side skids;
- Non-stop mechanical safety device.
