Over ground shredder TRP CV 145 and 175 with discharge spout for collecting vine shoots/prunings in bulk

In 2007, KUHN received a distinction award for innovation at the SITEVI 2007 for the TRP RT, over ground shredder enabling collecting shredded vine shoots/prunings in order to use them for producing energy.

Today KUHN presents a second system for collecting wood residues with the TRP, but this time, in bulk: the TRP CV, available in widths of 145 and 175 cm.

The two functions of the TRP RT are also present on the TRP CV:

- shredding, ensured by a shredder equipped with a pick-up that collects vine shoots/prunings on the ground and shreds them with the hammer-knives fitted rotor,
- harvesting the shredded wood residues

The difference with the TRP RT: vine shoots/prunings are recovered in bulk thanks to the discharge spout fitted to the rear of the shredder. The spout can be directed to the rear or side allowing to transfer the wood residues in a trailer coupled to a second tractor or to deliver them behind the TRP CV.

With this spout, you will be able to store prunings in bulk for future use as

- fuel.
- compost
- mulch for flowerbeds.

This shredder will also allow you to combat wood disease by removing contaminated vine shoots and prunings from the plots.

The shredding quality, essential for automatic furnace feeding, is ensured by aggressive counter-knives and a rotor fitted with hammer knives driven at high speed.
